Full Moon Rising by Keri Arthur (Sci-Fi)

When her twin brother, Rhoan, an assassin assigned the task of protecting the innocent from evil supernatural beings, vanishes while on one of his missions, dhampire Riley Jensen--a young woman who is half werewolf, half vampire--joins forces with the sexy, and very disoriented, vampire who shows up on her doorstep.

Aunt Dimity, Vampire Hunter by Nancy Atherton (Mystery)

Concerned for her preschooler twins' safety in the face of tales about a pale, blood-stained figure lurking in the nearby woods, Lori consults with her not-quite-departed **Aunt Dimity** and stumbles upon the truth about a forty-year-old murder.

Bone Crossed by Patricia Briggs (Sci-Fi)

Having been **crossed** by shapeshifting mechanic Mercy Thompson, local Vampire Queen Marsilia is out for revenge, but since Mercy enjoys the protection of the werewolf pack, Marsilia will need to find more indirect means of achieving her vengeance.

Fledgling by Octavia E. Butler (Sci-Fi)

Shori, a seemingly young, amnesiac girl with frightening inhuman abilities and a thirst for blood, wanders the land, unaware that she is really a genetically altered, fifty-three-year-old vampire with a unique ability to walk in the light of day and that she is the only survivor of a brutal attack on her community, searching for who she is and who wants to destroy her.

The Priest of Blood by Douglas Clegg (Sci-Fi)

The illegitimate son of a prostitute, a predator trainer in the royal court, and a conscripted soldier serving in the Crusades against the Saracens, Falconer finds his true destiny when he is transformed into a vampire by a creature called Pythia.

Undead and Unpopular by MaryJanice Davidson

As her birthday approaches, vampire queen Betsy Taylor finds herself playing politics with a group of European vampires who have come to pay their respects and coping with her reluctant fiance Eric, who is trying to dodge wedding plans.

Dark Curse by Christine Feehan

Escaping from her evil father to pursue her Carpathian destiny as a Dragonseeker, Lara Calladine is tormented by nightmares that may hold the key to the **dark** secrets of her childhood and joins forces with Nicolas De La Cruz to uncover the truth about both of their pasts.

Blood Red by Heather Graham

When a fortune-teller predicts her grisly death, Lauren Crow laughs it off, until she meets a self-proclaimed vampire hunter on a mission of vengeance, who plunges her into the middle of a vicious war between the living and the undead.

The Harlequin (and many other titles) by Laurell Hamilton

When vampire hunter Anita Blake confronts The **Harlequin**, terrifying, powerful creatures feared even by the centuries-old vampires, rivals Jean-Claude, Master Vampire of the City, and Richard, the alpha werewolf, must become allies.

Southern Vampires series by Charlaine Harris (Mystery)

Love blossoms between **Sookie Stackhouse**, a cocktail waitress in rural Louisiana who keeps to herself because of her ability to read minds, and Bill, a tall, dark, and handsome **vampire** with ties to a creepy crowd that may be responsible for the death of one of **Sookie's** coworkers. Basis for the *True Blood* Series on HBO.

For a Few Demons More by Kim Harrison

When **a** serial murderer begins killing off members of Hollows society, Rachel Morgan finds herself swept up in **a** brutal Inderland gang war, **a** situation that is complicated by her demonic nemesis, and the release of **a** vampire master.

White Witch, Black Curse by Kim Harrison (Sci-Fi)

Witch and bounty hunter Rachel Morgan won't rest until the death of her lover is solved and avenged, whatever the cost, but when an apex predator moves to the top of the Inderlander food chain, Rachel's past comes back to haunt her.

Lord of the Dead by Tom Holland

Lord Byron, **the** English Romantic poet, tells a young woman about his life, emphasizing his meeting in Greece with an old Turk who led him into **the** world **of** vampires.

The Society of S by Susan Hubbard

Thirteen-year-old half-vampire Ariella Montero struggles with the realities *of* her condition while harboring a desire to unravel the secrets *of* vampire nature, a longing that leads her to learn about the gentle, wise, and even vegetarian lifestyles *of* vampires.

The Historian by Elizabeth Kostova

Discovering a medieval *book* and a cache of letters, a motherless American girl becomes the latest in a series of *historians*, including her late father, who investigate the possible surviving legacy of Vlad the Impaler.

Necroscope: The Lost Years by Brian Lumley

Recounts vampire hunter Harry Keogh's most perilous encounter with the undead while desperately searching for his missing wife and son.

Descendant by Graham Masterton

During World War II, American James Falcon traveled across Europe, hunting vampires for the Allied forces. Now it's the late 1950s, and the cold war is hitting its stride. Falcon is called out of retirement and sent to London, where an old enemy has resurfaced. He quickly discovers that, to beat the bloodsucker, he must confront some frightening secrets from his own past.

Bloodsucking Fiends: A Love Story by Christopher Moore

When aspiring young writer Tommy Flood meets beautiful Jody on her nocturnal visit to the supermarket, he unwittingly begins an eternal relationship with a vampire.

You Suck: A Love Story by Christopher Moore

Waking up after a fantastic night only to discover that his girlfriend is a vampire and has transformed him into one, Thomas C. Flood adapts to his new powers while dealing with a dangerous faction of bloodsuckers trying to kill off all other vampires.

Vampire Chronicles and *New Tales of the Vampires* series by Anne Rice

Greywalker by Kat Richardson

Following a savage, near-fatal attack, private detective Harper Blaine discovers that she has become a *Greywalker*, and now has the ability to move between the ordinary world and a mysterious, cross-over zone populated by monsters.
